1 About the Programme

The **Carnival Learning Centre** on the Isle of Wight is delighted to be managing a new programme “Diverse leadership in outdoor arts” in partnership with Arts Council England South East. The scheme is designed to support the development of new leaders in the outdoor arts sector.

This programme will support four individuals from Black and Minority Ethnic communities to undertake a significant step change in their career development. Successful applicants will be offered a bursary of up to £3500 to enable them to follow a unique personalised training programme.

The personalised training programme might include:

- ◆ Specific training related to the production and management of outdoor arts events
- ◆ Attendance at key conferences or seminars
- ◆ The opportunity to work alongside major producers or production teams
- ◆ The opportunity to undertake research visits to major artistic events
- ◆ Support and mentoring from the Carnival Learning Centre

Applications will be considered by Arts Council England South East and the Carnival Learning Centre against the following criteria:

- ◆ The level of current involvement in the outdoor arts sector
- ◆ The difference the bursary could make to the individuals leadership potential
- ◆ Originality of ideas for using the award for training purposes
- ◆ Future plans for working in the outdoor arts sector

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for interview at the Arts Council England Offices in Brighton on Monday 26th October 2009

The programme is only open to individuals living and working in the South East (Kent, Medway, East Sussex, Brighton and Hove, West Sussex, Hampshire, Isle of Wight, Oxfordshire, Berkshire and Buckinghamshire)
